Display Case: If anyone would like to display "treasures" at the library, please call Shelly at 785-258-2011 to schedule a display.

Tax Forms: It's unknown when or if the library receive tax forms this year. They have been ordered but there's been no word if they will be sent. If a person knows the tax form number or schedule, library staff can look it up on the computer and print it. There is a 15 cent per page charge to print.

Test Proctor Service: For those taking on-line classes, the library offers test proctor services. Please contact the library director to arrange for testing.

Book Group: The book group meets the first Monday of the month at 7 p.m. Anyone wanting to join is welcome. There is no need to purchase the book. Books (sometime large print and also on CD) are available to check out. Discussions typically last about an hour.

Laminating Machine: The library now has a laminating machine? Anyone having documents, photos, certificates, etc. can be laminated at the library for only \$1 per sheet. The machine will cover items up to 11x17-inches.

Copy, Print and Fax Machine: Staff members can make black and white copies or patrons may print information from the computers for 15 cents per page. Color prints are 25 cents per page.

Faxes being sent or received are \$1 for the first page, or 50 cents for each additional page. The fax number is 785-258-3260. Call to inform the library a fax is being sent to this number.

Sick: The Herington Public Library staff respectfully ask that those who are sick (throwing up, running a fever, terrible cough, etc.) to stay home or wear a mask. HPL staff seeks to keep the library as healthy as possible for patrons.

Home Delivery: Don't forget, library staff members will deliver books or other library materials, if needed. Call the library at 785-258-2011 for more information or to request items.

Handicapped Accessibility: When anyone needs to use the library elevator, please ring the door bell on the south door of the library. Staff will unlock the door. Patrons can access any level of the library from the elevator. Anyone needing help with the elevator may request it.

Outreach: The Herington Public Library is willing to offer outreach programs. If school classes or daycare providers want the Children's Librarian to visit to read stories and/or provide activities, make arrangements by calling the library or contact Ms. Susan.
